2/11-2/17	Race Headquarters and Competition Office	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Greet coaches, athletes, and officials • Pass along information and documentation • Run errands
2/12-2/17	Course Marshall	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Setup and maintenance of the ski tracks • Work with the Course Crew to lay v-board, smooth corners • Keep eager crowds at bay
2/12-2/17	Medical Team	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow instructions of the Medical Director to help with care of athletes and the public • Be a calming presence to an injured individual
2/12-2/17	Range Crew	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Help prepare a perfect firing line • Change paper during zero period • Record shooting data
2/12-2/17	Timing Team	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Support the timing crews • Help with setup and dispatched of timing equipment during events
2/12-2/17	Start/Finish Control Officers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keep the show running on time and according to the books • Guide athletes to the start line • Welcomes athletes after the finish • Provide support in the crucial competition zones
2/4-2/10	Media Set Up	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move equipment to make sure every camera position, feeder cable, advertising banner, and checkpoint is perfectly placed • Pay close attention to detail • Have a general understanding of screw guns
2/12-2/17	Stadium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pay attention to detail and follow precise layouts • Set up and break down the venue for training and event days
2/4-2/10	Snowmobile Driver	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Operate a machine safely and efficiently • Work with venue teams to move broadcast, media, and course equipment around the venue • Feel free to bring your own snowmobile
2/11-2/17	Car Driver	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drive personnel and the public to different sites around the venue • Must be comfortable driving on unpaved roads, in snow, and with people walking around
2/13-2/17	Communication and Event Support	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Carry information between the range and timing Crew • Work backstage in the media room during athlete interviews • Show a dignitary to their seat • Complete random tasks as assigned
2/11-2/17	Welcoming & Parking Credentials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Welcome athletes and guests to the venue • Check credentials • Provides general event information.
